Details: Residents on Churchgate Avenue have an ongoing problem for the last few years with rubbish and waste management. There is an area on the road (behind Hessions who genuinely try to monitor the issue) where local businesses store their bins. Unfortunately it’s regularly overrun with rubbish. The rubbish is left on the road and we have to move it ourselves to drive to our homes.

Recently and thankfully, the owners of the Sheds pub have erected a gate with a lock for the businesses to store their rubbish but the lock was broken and the rubbish is still dumped on our road. When the gate is left open needlessly, the area attracts people who use the space as a toilet or to congregate and drink making us feel very unsafe walking to our homes especially at night.

Some restaurants have left huge planks and plastic outside the gate and it has been blowing up and down the road. The planks have blown down in front of cars. When they were asked to move them, they left them propped up against a shop on Vernon Avenue.

Business bins regularly blow out onto the street or prevent us from turning the corner in our cars. The off licence also attracts people who drink outside the shop and leave broken bottles. One resident witnessed one of the restaurants on Vernon Avenue pouring grease from their pots down the street drains at night. There are rats in the area and these houses open onto the street so it has become an intolerable situation.

Residents have previously contacted Dublin City Council and they realise that the area where the bins are stored is private property but this area isn’t being used and Churchgate Avenue and the bins and rubbish are being stored on the street. This is in turn attracting illegal dumping.

Residents would really appreciate assistance from DCC so we can finally and once and for all solve this problem

With the very tight entrance caused by the cars, as I own an estate a large one that is low to the ground, every time I leave my house now the front valance scrapes on the high curb as I have to drive over it to get in and out.If it was possible to widen the entrance, this would give us more room to get into the driveway.”
