Clareville continues to provide dinners 5 days each week for the Glasnevin Area.

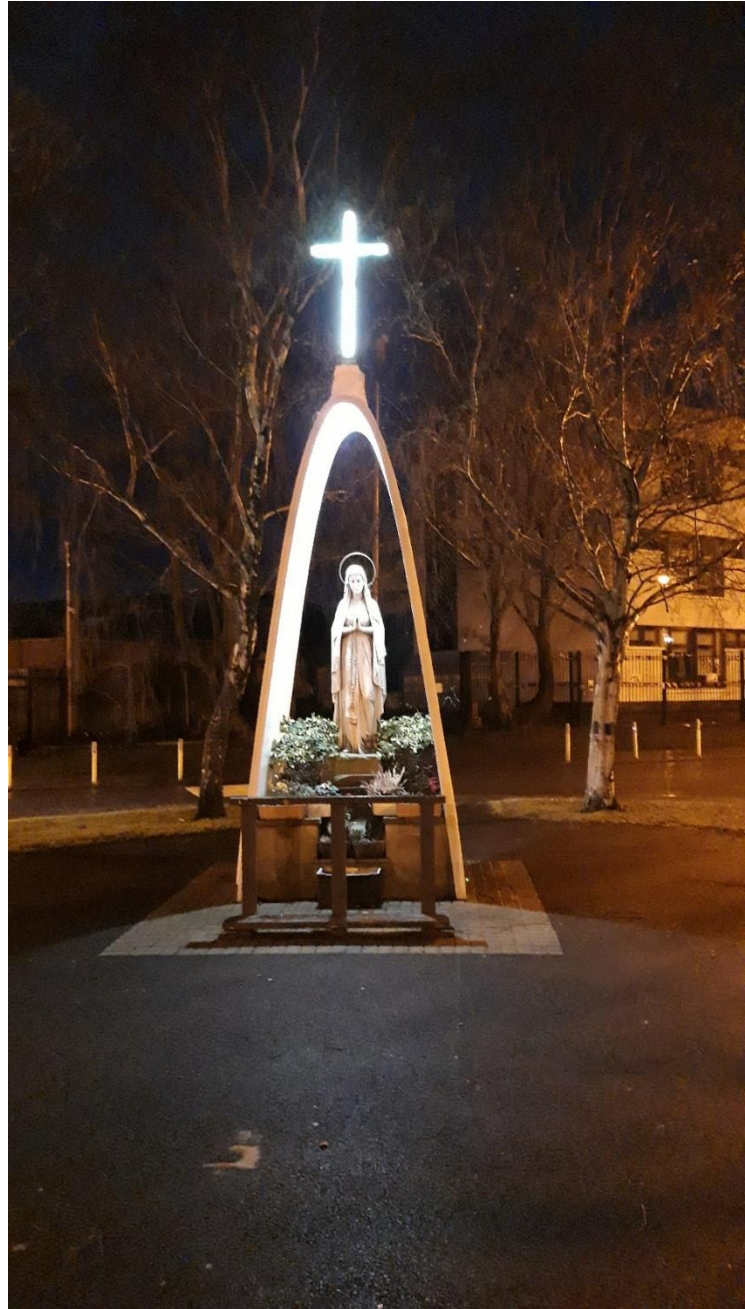

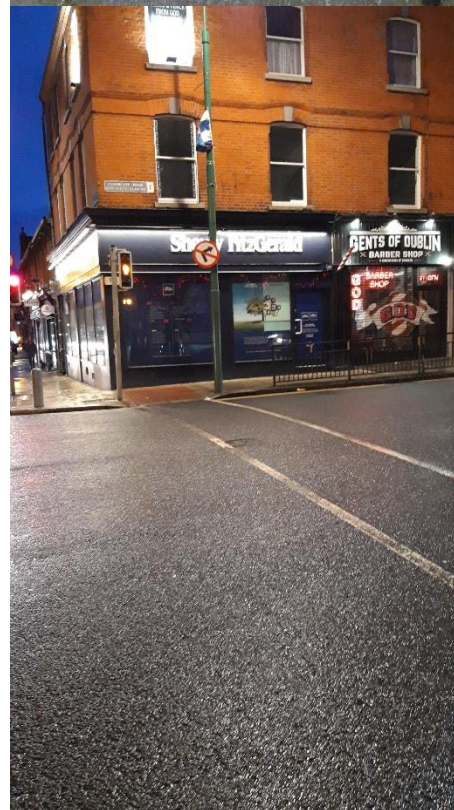
