



With reference to the proposed extinguishment of the public right of way over that part of the lane that is to the rear of the dwellings at Goldsmith Street, Berkeley Road, Saint Vincent's Street North and North Circular Road, Dublin 7.

Proposal

A request, to have the public right of way extinguished over the lane at the rear of 45 to 54 Goldsmith Street, 22A to 37 Berkeley Road, 2 to 9 Saint Vincent's Street North and 386 to 396 North Circular Road has been made.

The reason for this extinguishment is to eliminate anti-social behaviour and the dumping of litter and waste over the referred lane. The extent of this proposed extinguishment is shown on the attached Map RM 37539.

The Central Area Committee, at its meeting on the 12th January 2021, agreed to initiate the statutory procedure to extinguish the public right of way over this laneway under the provisions of Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993.

Statutory

By public advertisement, on the 29th day of October 2020, representations or objections were invited to be received by or before the 11st day of December 2021. The site notices were erected on the 29th day of October 2020. No objections were received.

Service Check

A service check has been carried out and no service provider will need to alter the current services on or under the referred Lane. Accessibilities arrangements, for such service providers, shall be made through the Central Area Office or those private customers that are engaged with that service provider(s).

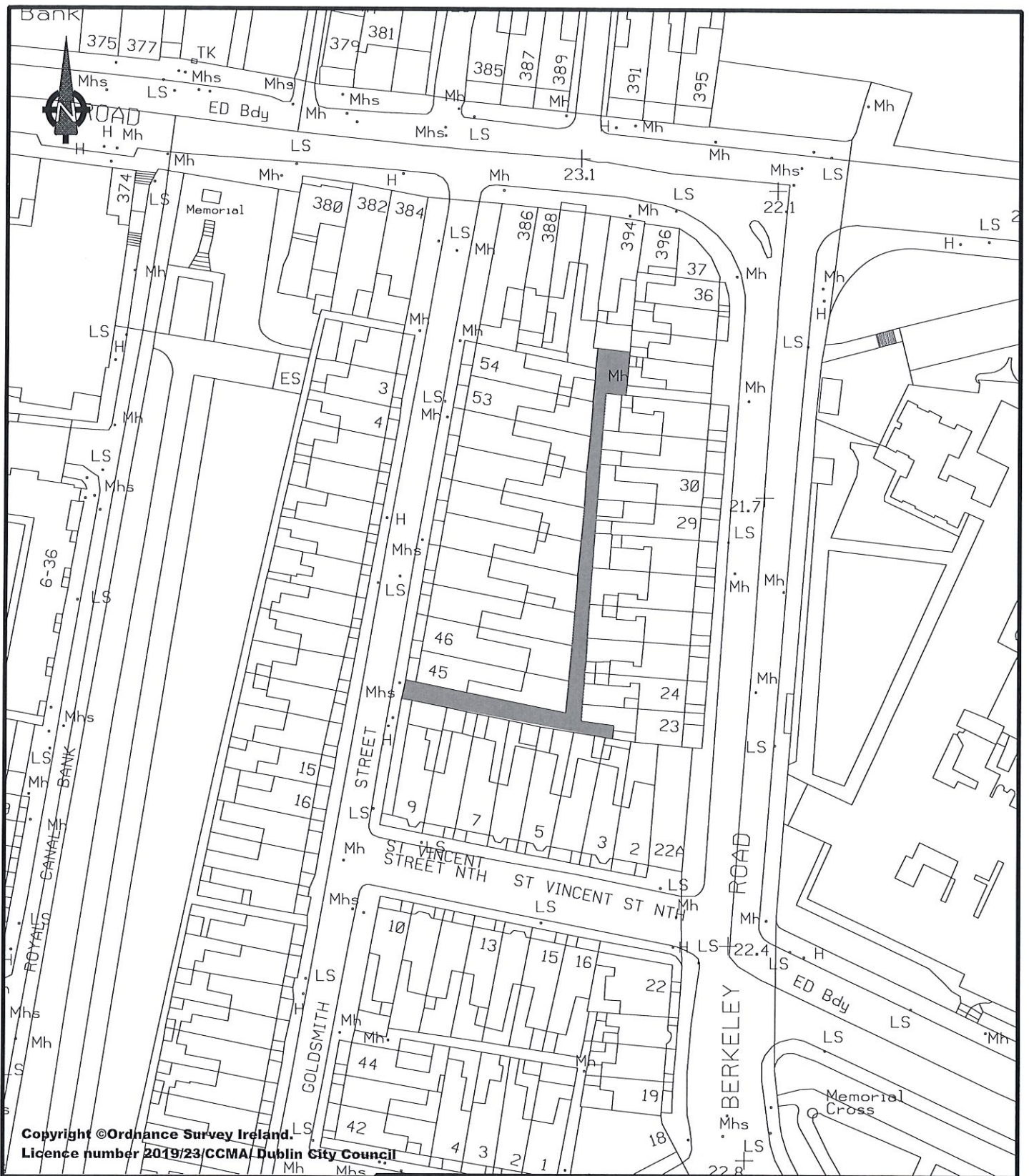
Recommendation

I recommend that the extinguishment of the public right of way over the area shown on Drawing No. RM 37539 be approved by the City Council. The extinguishment of a public right of way is a function reserved to the City Council.

Resolution:

That We, the Lord Mayor and Members of Dublin City Council, being the Roads Authority for the City of Dublin and being of the opinion that the Public Right of Way over that part of the lane that is to the rear of the dwellings at Goldsmith Street, Berkeley Road, Saint Vincent's Street North and North Circular Road, Dublin 7. as shown on the attached Drawing RM 37539 is no longer required for public use, extinguish the public right of way in accordance with Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993.
