- There has been no Murder's recorded in 2021.
- There has been 79 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2021 as opposed to 157 for the same period in 2020, a **decrease** of 50%
- There has been a total of 19 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2021 in comparison to 10 for the same period in 2020, an **increase** of 90%
- There has been No Fatal Road Traffic Collisions recorded in 2021.
- 235 Public Order Incidents were recorded in 2021 as opposed to 315 incidents in the same period last year, showing a **decrease** of 25%
- 43 Incidents of Drunkenness were recorded in 2021 as opposed to 70 in the same period last year, a **decrease** of 39%
- 10 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm were recorded in 2021, as opposed to 39 in the same period last year, a **decrease** of 74%
- 24 incidents of Minor Assault were recorded in 2021 as opposed to 106 in the same period last year showing a **decrease** of 77%

It should be noted that in any reference to statistics, those statistics are provisional, operational, liable to change and some possibly re-classified with the introduction of Central Statistics Office reports.
