- There has been 1 Murder recorded in the previous 12 months (March 2021). This Murder has now been detected.
- There has been 94 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2021 as opposed to 176 for the same period in 2020, a **decrease** of 47%
- There has been a total of 31 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2021 in comparison to 36 arrests for the same period in 2020, a **decrease** of 14%
- There has been 1 Fatal Road Traffic Collisions recorded in 2021.
- 683 Public Order Incidents were recorded in 2021 as opposed to 631 incidents in the same period last year, showing an **increase** of 8%
- 110 Incidents of Drunkenness were recorded in 2021 as opposed to 132 in the same period last year, a **decrease** of 17%
- 50 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm were recorded in 2021, as opposed to 64 in the same period last year, a **decrease** of 22%
- 91 incidents of Minor Assault were recorded in 2021 as opposed to 162 in the same period last year showing a **decrease** of 44%

It should be noted that in any reference to statistics, those statistics are provisional, operational, liable to change and some possibly re-classified with the introduction of Central Statistics Office reports.
