3. Management Update – Programmes & Services	<p>Aideen O’Connor presented on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Virtual Hub – Over 2,000 people registered. Started on 15th Mar and is currently in the 4th week. Pre-recorded sessions are a popular way to access sessions. John Gillick gave thoughts on how to get the best use of promotion and awareness. ➤ Keep Well – Older adults online classes currently happening averaging 90 per class and feedback is positive from members of the public who felt isolated. Plans for 2 more programmes - open water and after school. ➤ Lord Mayor’s 5 Alive Challenge – up to 400 participants and feedback was very positive. ➤ Orienteering – 3 main groups targeted. schools, yourh & families ➤ Sport for Young People Grant 80 applications received to date expected 150 by deadline 23rd April ➤ Active Cities. This is broken up into themes between cities. Publicity and Marketing aspect will go to tender. Aideen to circulate year 1 action plan. 		
4. Strategy	<p>It is proposed to an interim strategy for 2021 and then look at creating a new plan from 2022 and align alongside City Development Plan. The previous plan is to be evaluated internally first by questionnaire followed by a facilitated session to be led by John Foley, Kevin Quinn and Fiona Coughlan.
