1	7020314		Traffic Calming	BALLYGALL AVENUE (NW)	Dublin 11	examine the signage and traffic calming measures	Not Recommended	<p>For the most part, there is on street parking which is effectively acting as traffic calming by physically narrowing the carriageway and reducing driver's forward visibility. Ballygall Avenue is a narrow road and also is short in length (approx. 130 meters) and not conducive to speed.</p> <p>Ballygall Avenue is covered by the 30 km/h Slow Zone, indicating the lower speed limit and that the area is a Home Zone/Slow Zone, which warns motorists that it is a residential area and to expect children.</p> <p>In addition to the information above, is not recommended the provision of extra traffic calming measures at this time.</p> <p>Under the Road Traffic Regulations, traffic on a road ending at a T junction must give way to traffic from either direction on the other road. A Stop/Yield sign is not necessary where normal rules of the road apply. Such signs are only provided on approaches to major junctions as otherwise this would lead to a proliferation of signs throughout residential estates.</p>	Councillor	30/04/2021	0

Recommended	<p>During a site visit no adverse problems regarding the wall causing a blind spot on Marewood Crescent at the junction with Barnwell Dr and Marewood Dr. Visibility for cars exiting from mentioned roads was observed to be good.</p> <p>A stop line associated with a worded STOP Marking is provided on Barnwell Dr at the junction with Marewood Crescent that imposes a requirement on all approaching traffic to stop and may only continue if is safe to do.</p> <p>However, in order to alleviate confusion at the cross junction Marewood Crescent / Marewood Dr / Sandyhill Gardens, it is recommended to be installed a stop line with an associated stop marking on Marewood Dr.</p> <p>STAT: On Marewood Dr at the junction with Marewood Crescent install a Stop Line RRM 017 with an associated worded STOP Marking (M114) and a Single Centre Line (RRM 001) starting from a point in line with Stop Line RRM 017 extending 8 meters in a West direction.</p>	Councillor	16/06/2021	0
3	7021705		Disab Park Bay General	BALLYMUN ROAD (NW)	Dublin 9	disabled parking outside the Ballymun Health Center	Recommended	<p>In order to provide an easy access to Ballymun Healthcare Facility, Intreo Centre and Pharmacy, it is recommended to install a disabled parking bay on Ballymun Road.</p> <p>STAT: Rescind Pay & Display (10.00-16.00 – MON-SAT) on the East side of Ballymun Road, from the lamp standard 113 extending southwards for approx. 5 meters</p> <p>STAT: On the East side of Ballymun Road, from the lamp standard 113, install a disabled parking bay accompanied by the upright Disabled Persons' parking in a South direction.</p>	TD	19/07/2021	0
