- There has been 1 Murder recorded in the previous 12 months (March 2021). This Murder has now been detected.
- There has been 134 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2021 as opposed to 276 for the same period in 2020, a decrease of 51%
- There has been a total of 48 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2021 in comparison to 55 arrests for the same period in 2020, a **decrease** of 13%
- There has been 1 Fatal Road Traffic Collisions recorded in 2021 (April 2021).
- 1139 Public Order Incidents were recorded in 2021 as opposed to 1081 incidents in the same period last year, showing an increase of 5%
- 186 Incidents of Drunkenness were recorded in 2021 as opposed to 206 in the same period last year, a decrease of 10%
- 102 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm were recorded in 2021, as opposed to 91 in the same period last year, an increase of 12%
- 201 incidents of Minor Assault were recorded in 2021 as opposed to 237 in the same period last year showing a **decrease** of 15% It should be noted that in any reference to statistics, those statistics are provisional, operational, liable to change and some possibly reclassified with the introduction of Central Statistics Office reports.
