## Community Grants Scheme 2020 and 2021

---

On an annual basis, Dublin City Council provides support through once-off local and city wide grants to a range of resident, community, environmental and festival groups throughout the city with a particular emphasis on community development and social inclusion. Within the context of the impact of COVID19, this report gives a summary outcome of the 2020 scheme and presents details of the outcome of 2021 scheme for adoption.

### 2020

The community grants budget for 2020 was approved by the City Council as part of the annual budgetary process. The 2020 grant application process began in the latter months of 2019 and closed on 8<sup>th</sup> November 2019 with 1,081 valid applications received and assessed, of which 888 grants were recommended. Each Area Committee received and approved its individual area based report outlining the grants recommended.

The total amount initially recommended for 2020 was €879,650. This comprised €300,000 for local Area projects, €86,500 for Informal Adult Education projects, €123,900 for the Tom Clarke Bridge Grant Scheme, €140,000 for Summer Project and €229,250 for City Wide and Social Inclusion Grants.

Over the period from the onset of COVID-19 in early 2020, Ireland's public health requirements and the related societal restrictions adopted in response severely restricted and disrupted the ability of community groups and organisations to continue their activities in full or in part. Much of the activity that was the focus of DCC community grants awarded in 2020 was also interrupted by Covid-19 and could not take place.

Recognising the major pressure on communities throughout the city and the important and vital role of many voluntary groups who were to the fore in assisting those most vulnerable in our communities, including the elderly, Dublin City Council proposed a full review of assessed and approved grants in 2020.

This was to ensure the Community Grant Scheme continued to support groups and organisations where possible. The review of 888 assessed and recommended grants summing to a total of €879,650 was agreed by City Councillors in September 2020.

Each applicant organisation or group was subsequently contacted to re-affirm whether their activities were continuing under COVID-19 restrictions and how these were being adapted and changed accordingly.

Scheme applicants were supported in adapting their proposed activities, events, projects and services etc to comply with the required public health restrictions. By November, the review had resulted in a sum of €572,476 being approved for the Community Grant Scheme. A breakdown of this sum against category of spend is given below:

## 2021

The challenges of living with COVID-19 while observing all public health requirements and social restrictions was particularly acute during 2021. To maintain our continuity of service and support to community and voluntary groups this required our Community Grant Scheme administrative process be further adapted.

As the 2020 scheme successfully supported a range of events, activities, services and projects where compliance with all required public health restrictions that accompanied COVID19 were demonstrable and achieved as a condition of the grant, it was agreed that at minimum for 2021 we needed to ensure we continued to enable applications for grants and financial assistance from previously successful applicants.

This required an extensive communication effort between DCC Area Offices and Community Development section throughout 2021 to confirm the continued eligibility and availability of the 2020 grantee groups and organisations and to ensure their project, service, activity or event remained compliant with, and adjusted to, all levels of required public health requirements.

We also worked closely with the DCC Community Call team administering our COVID19 Emergency Fund and the DCC Local Community Development Committee (LCDC) team administering the Community Enhancement Funds (CEP) and the Healthy Ireland Community Resilience Funds for Dublin city. This enabled us identify additional groups and organisations eligible for DCC Community Grant Scheme.

All 2021 applications were assessed in the context of available finance, value to the community and compliance with the relevant policies and objectives of the Council and in particular with relevance to the city's Community Development action plans at local level and all relevant strategy regarding social inclusion and integration.

Set out below (Annex 1) are summary details of all finalised and assessed applications for 2021 together with recommendations in relation to the amount of grant assistance proposed. DCC Area Committees received their respective individual report outlining the grants recommended in their area in December 2021. All grant reports were approved at Area Committee and are included here in Appendices 1 to 5. City Wide Social Inclusion grants are detailed in Appendix 6.

The final value for all community grants 2021 is €585,375. It is recommended that Dublin City Council approve the grants to the groups as set out in the report below. There is provision in the budget to meet this expenditure.

The current grant process while providing good governance and oversight has become cumbersome, laborious and difficult for Community groups to navigate. The balance between efficiency and oversight needs to be reviewed to assist groups and volunteers at the frontline of community development. DCC remains committed to the provision of a revised and improved Community Grant Scheme in 2022.
