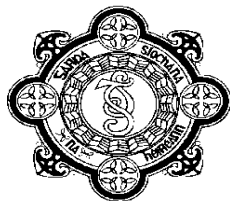

**Crime Prevention
Matters and Other
Information**

All victims of Domestic Violence in D11 are receiving a call back with a view to providing Crime Prevention Advice.

Victims of Drug debt intimidation are offered Crime Prevention Advice and an Inspector is also appointed to monitor all cases of Drug Debt intimidation.

There are special dedicated patrols by Garda teams, uniform and plain clothes, in the Finglas area who engage in patrols, check points and assisting regular units in responding to calls from the public when necessary.

It should be noted that in any reference to statistics, those statistics are provisional, operational, liable to change and some possibly re-classified with the introduction of Central Statistics Office reports.
