Litter Hotline/CRM

In the period 1st – 30th June 2022, incidents were reported via Litter Hotline/CRM for the Central Area.

In addition to the CRM incidents, the Public Domain crew carry out inspections of their assigned routes on a daily basis. Collecting any dumped bags/materials which is not reflected on the above figures.

Overtime

Over time was carried out Sunday 5th June with 2.48 tonne being removed from the area.

Over time is scheduled for Sunday 3rd July to concentrate on the removal of weeds from requested streets such as Fitzgibbon Street and Newcomen Avenue.

Community Clean-ups

Community Clean up equipment was distributed to **10** Community Groups / individuals between 1st–30th June. Requests for the removal of bags from community clean ups were handled by Waste Management and Public Domain staff.
