JULY MEETING OF THE NORTH CENTRAL AREA COMMITTEE**

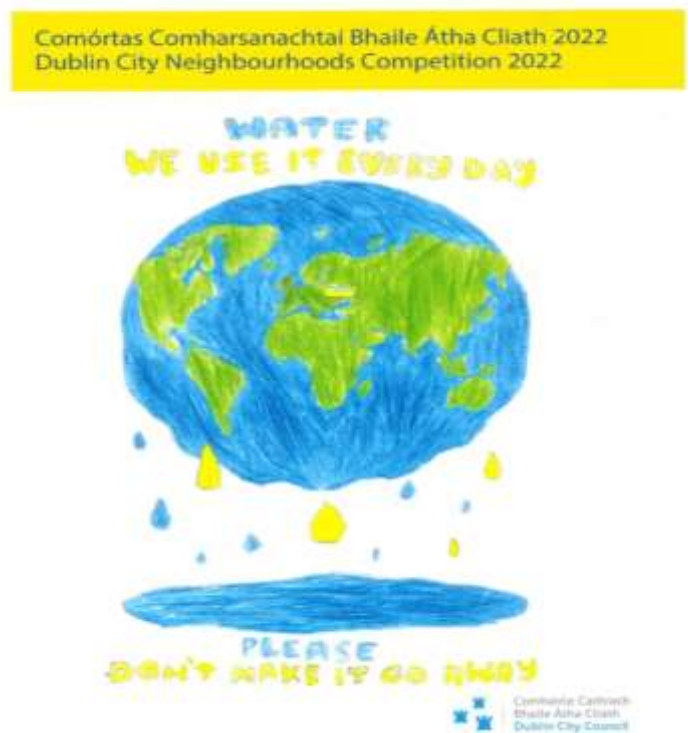
Environmental Groups
