Not Recommended	Not recommended – there are currently plans to extend the cycle track on the south side of Griffith Avenue up to the junction with Ballygall Road East, with construction looking to begin in early Q4 2022. Once the cycle lane is extended and installed, it will no longer be necessary to install road markings as all traffic will be coming from a single lane on the eastern arm of the junction.
