Cities for a Nuclear Free Europe keeps you informed about urban activities about nuclear energy in Europe.

The yearly Viennese Nuclear Symposium is planned to take place again in September this year, already for the 13th time.

The Viennese Nuclear Symposium is a yearly meeting of science, government and NGO's to discuss relevant or new insights of nuclear energy in an informal atmosphere.

The Viennese Nuclear Symposia are jointly organized by the Vienna Ombuds Office for Environmental Protection with the Institute of Safety and Risk Sciences (ISR) in Vienna.

This year's theme of the Symposium is:

Nuclear Energy in Germany 2022 – The End of an Era

The 13th Vienna Nuclear Symposium will focus on Germany's phase-out of nuclear energy by the end of 2022. The last still running reactors (Emsland, Isar 2 and Neckarwestheim 2) will be taken off the grid by then. At the symposium, an effort will be made to take stock of the past nuclear era in Germany and also look into the future. This also involves the sustainable energy transition in Europe and the attempts to give nuclear power a role in it.

This years symposium will be held in the Festival Hall of the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences (BOKU). Gregor-Mendel-Straße 33, 3. Stock, 1180 Vienna.
