Dear Mayor,

I write to you with regard to the matter of local government funding and in particular to the report commissioned by Dublin City Council's Finance Strategic Policy Committee (SPC), (copy attached), *Review of Local Government Funding as applies to Dublin City Council*, Grant Thornton. The Finance SPC has established a sub-committee to progress the objectives and recommendations of the commissioned review. I also attach details of the sub-committee membership and Terms of Reference for your information.
