I had thought I responded to this when we first received it.

Waste Enforcement have never been involved in the removal of waste from this site and as such have no record of historical costs waste removal costs. As far as I am aware waste has been removed by the Area Office on a number of occasions and by Housing Department (Traveller Accommodation Section) at the start of this Summer.

Waste Enforcement Section have no evidence on the person or persons involved in illegal dumping at this site and as such there has been no communications with the Revenue Commissioners, An Garda Síochana or the Criminal Assets Bureau (CAB) on any identified individuals. However Waste Enforcement have been engaged in regular roadside checkpoints with An Garda Síochana in this area over the last two years and will continue this cooperation with An Garda in order to assist in preventing further instances of illegal dumping.
