Similar technology already exists on buses in San Francisco, Lausanne (Switzerland), Trikala (Greece), Zhengzhou (China) and Wageningen (The Netherlands).”

**Following discussion of the Motion, Cllr P. Smyth agreed to re-word his Motion as follows:**
