With reference to a Naming and Numbering proposal for a development at 20-23a Stoneybatter, and Nos. 1-2a Manor Street, Stoneybatter, Dublin 7.

Development information:

This is a new student accommodation development on the site of Nos. 20-23a Stoneybatter, and Nos. 1-2a Manor Street, Stoneybatter, Dublin 7 as shown on the attached drawing SM-2022-0432. The development will consist of the demolition of all existing structures on site and the construction of a part 3 No. storey to part 5 No. storey Student Accommodation development. It will comprise a main block and a Gatehouse building at No. 20 Stoneybatter providing a total of 142 No. student accommodation bedspaces. The 142 No. bedspaces are provided in 19 No. cluster units comprising of 3 No. four bedroom clusters, 1 No. six bedroom cluster, 6 No. seven bedroom clusters and 9 No. eight bedroom clusters; 4 No. studio units and 6 No. bedspaces within the Gatehouse building.

Address Proposal:

The developer advised that name "Teach Ghairgéid / Garget House" is proposed as it derived from the name of a meadow located in proximity of the development. The Manor House was conferred to Right Hon. Francis Asgard in 1559 by Royal mandate. He also received a barn, a kiln, a sheepfold, an orchard, a meadow called Garget's Mead"
