# What is Net Zero Cities?

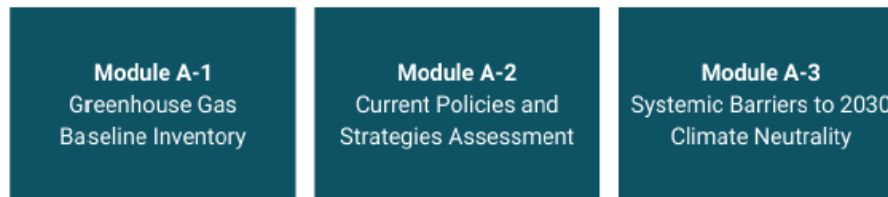

# How will this be achieved?

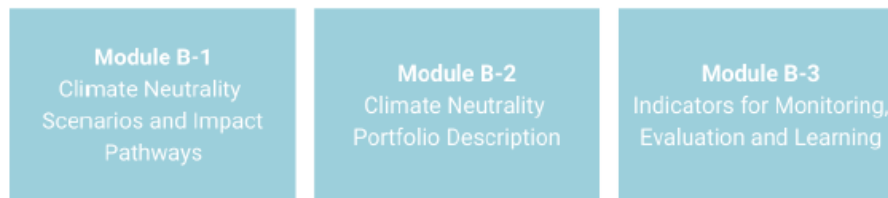
The pathway is divided into a number of modules design to result in an implementation plan towards a climate neutral Dublin City by 2030

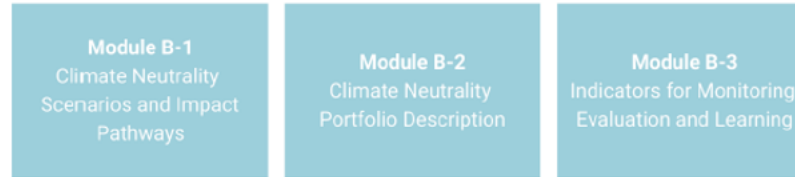

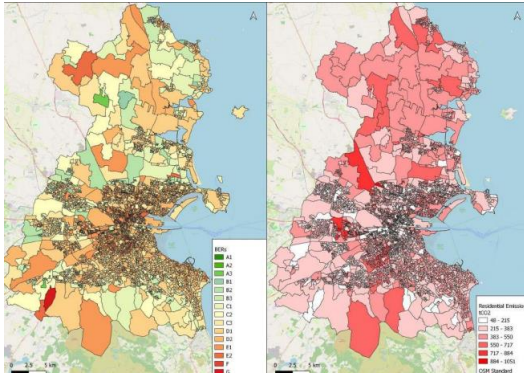
# What's in it for Dublin City?
