Community & Social Development

Seamus Ennis Event

The Community & Social Development Section (CSDS) is organising a small number of events to celebrate and acknowledge the contribution Seamus Ennis made to Irish music.

To create awareness and promote the work of Seamus Ennis the CSDS has invited local schools to participate in "Piper's Day". Niamh Landale a 15-year-old piper will visit schools to speak about Seamus Ennis and to give a demonstration of the uileann pipes.

To date two schools have applied and the team will reconnect with the schools after the Easter holidays.

The Area Office in conjunction with the Seamus Ennis Centre in The Naul, Co. Dublin will host a musical, storytelling and poetry event in Erin's Isle on the 10th May at 7.00 pm.

This will be a ticketed event, tickets will be available free of charge from the Seamus Ennis Arts Centre website.

Finglas Racing Pigeon Club

The Finglas Racing Pigeon Club are looking at ways to support older member's access the club as well as encouraging new members. Internally the facility needs a lot of work, disability toilets are required as well as an up- grade in the lighting system. Membership of the club has fallen since Covid and this has impacted on funding from membership fees with the group struggling to meet insurance requirements.

The CSDS met with representatives of the Club on Wednesday 29th March and will support the club in this regard.

Dublin City Community Enhancement & Support Fund

The Department of Rural and Community Development (DRCD), through the Dublin City Local Community Development Committee (LCDC) and Dublin City Council, is funding a **Community Support Fund (CSF)**.

A total of €576,625 is available under this fund

The Programme has a focus on supporting groups in disadvantaged areas. Typical enhancements under the CEP include:

- IT equipment
- improvements to buildings
- renovation of community centres
- development of community amenities
- purchase of equipment for community usage
- improvements to town parks, common areas and energy-saving projects

The closing date for applications under the scheme was Friday 31st March. The CSDS promoted the scheme within the Finglas area and assisted a number of local groups to make applications.

Age Friendly Classes

The chair based exercises and adapted tai chi will commence on the 17th of April at 9.30am in the Finglas Youth Resorce Centre, Mellowes Road, Finglas, D11 P654.

Due to the popularity of the classes they will now be held in a bigger venue in Finglas Youth Resource Centre which can hold up to 30 participants.

Launch of Finglas Summer Projects – date change

All Finglas based Summer Projects are invited to an information evening to launch their programmes for 2023.

The launch/information evening date has been changed and the launch will take place on Tuesday 18th of April at 6.00pm in The Den, Finglas South.

The Finglas area has 8 Summer Projects running programmes this year. The projects play an important role in providing positive activities for young people of all ages in the area over the summer months.

Summer Project volunteers will be provided with information packs, application forms and training dates as well as light refreshments for all the volunteers.

Walkability Survey Update

The CSDS are currently working on completing the list of works and Issues that were highlighted from the Griffith Crescent Complex Walkability Survey.

- Residents expressed in interest in setting up some activities in the community room. Complete – DCC Sports officer has been in contact with the residents and will put an exercise programme in place. The Community Team are currently organising another weekly activity programme for residents.
- Issues with children causing nuisance and noise at the complex The Community Team is working with the Parks Department to identify a green space in neighbouring Griffith Heights as a new location for the Finglas Teen Space – This should deter children from hanging around the complex.
- Bushes/shrubs are hard to maintain in the communal garden. Complete Probation services are currently cutting back bushes and clearing weeds from site.
- Gutters in the complex need to be cleaned and cleared Housing Manager has organised cleaning works in the coming weeks.
- Back wall of communal garden is an eyesore. Complete – Parks Department will plant wild flowers in April.
- Uneven paving in a couple of areas of the complex Finglas Housing Manager is currently working on resolving this matter.
- > Bin room needs deep clean Cleansing Section are currently working on deep clean.
- Back laneways of the apartment complex need to be weeded and cleared. Complete Probation Services are currently working on this area.
- Planting site at the front of the Community Room needs to be cleaned and cleared. Complete – Probation Services are currently working on this area.

Outside Complex Issues

Pathways need to be cleared of debris and overgrown shrubs – walkway along Glasnevin Downs. Works in Progress – Contractor procured, awaiting start date.

- Issues with high amount of illegal dumping behind the fencing along Glasnevin Downs. Fencing is to be taken down and site to be completely cleared. Works in Progress – Contractor procured, awaiting start date

- Road signs/markings and dishing These issues have been highlighted with the Traffic and Road Maintenance Departments for inspection.
