1. **Miontuairisci** - Glacadh leis na Miontuairisci
2. **Nithe a bhaineann leis na Miontuairisci** - tá gach rud ar an gclár
3. **Lá Mór na Gaeilge 2023** - Dúirt Micheál Ó Nualláin go bhfuil an coiste stiúrtha ag bualadh go coicísúil faoi Lá Mór na Gaeilge (Donncha, Orla, Ray, Julian agus duine nó beirt eile). Ní bheidh an ócáid i bhfad níos mó ná anuraidh ach beidh Club na Múinteoirí mar suíomh eile ar an lá. Is 130 bhliain ó cuireadh túis le hAthbheochain na Gaeilge agus beidh Athbheochain na Gaeilge mar théama do LMnaG i mbliana. Tá duine aimsithe acuanois chun plé leis an bPlean Bainistíocha Éigeandála [EMP], agus leis na Gardaí Síochána 7rl ar an lá. Tá sé i dteagmháil leis na mbunscoileanna agus na nGaelcholáistí ionas go mbeidh siad ar an eolas faoin ócáid. Tá sé ar intinn acu comórtas ealaíne a eagrú, má bhíonn an Dánlann Hugh Lane sásta agus cuirfear a gcuid saothair ar theaspaint sa Hugh Lane i rith an lae. Beidh seó tallaine do na mbunscoileanna agus cogadh na mbannaí leis na Gaelcholáistí ar siúl ar an lá, le réamhbhabhtaí más gá roimh réidh. Tá siad ag dul i gcomhairle freisin le daoine atá ag obair sna healaíona maidir le imeachtaí ealaíne ar an lá.

D'íarr Comhairleoir Heney le cóip den dréacht clár a fháil agus bhí plé faoiimeachtaí Lá Mór na Gaeilge chomh maith le moltaí do thaibheoirí sráide ón Comhairleoir Ring. Dúirt Micheál Ó Nualláin go mbeadh an Fear Ghrinn 'Giggles' ann arís. Dheimhnigh Micheál go mbeadh an Athbheochán na Gaeilge an téama don lá agus beidh cainteanna ar an téama seo le béim ar Ilchultúrthas agus na Éireannaigh nua.Luaigh an Comhairleoir Heney go bhfuil sagart Úcráin

i nDomhnach Cearna go bhfuil Gaeilge aige agus dúirt Miceál go ndéanfaidh sé teagmháil leis.

Róinn an Cathaoirleach litir ó Des Geraghty atá ag lorg maoiniú chun taibhiú sa Halla Saoirse a chur ar siúl. Tá bailiúchán d'amhráin Ghaeilge aige faoi Bhaile Átha Cliath. Dúirt Ray Yeates go ndéanfaidh sé teagmháil leis chun an t-ábhar a phlé. Dúirt An Comhairleoir Nial Ring go bhfuil Halla na Saoirse suite sa Lár Cheantair agus más féidir le Des iarratas a sheoladh chuige go ndéanfadh sé iarracht roinnt airgid a chur ar fáil ón gciste roghnach.

4. BÁC le Gaeilge:

Labhair Micheál Ó Nualláin faoin gciste tacaíochta do ghnólachtaí a úsáideann an Ghaeilge. Dúirt sé go bhfuil buiséad deich míle euro acu le fógraíochta an theanga nó Gaeilge amháin a chur in airde sa líonra atá againn? Tá siad ag bailiú na híomhanna dóibh sin agus beidh siad ag bualadh leis na ngnólachtaí a bheadh ag dul amach ar na meáin. Tá 35 gnólachtaí ag glacadh páirt agus tá leibhéal éagsúla líofachta acu sa Ghaeilge. Tar éis Lá Mór na Gaeilge beidh siad ag seoladh scéim tacaíochta nua le ranganna nó ceardlanna ar sheirbhís chustaiméiri a bheadh saor in aisce. Araon leis sin tá siad ag obair ar Sheachtain na Gaeilge. Ghabh Micheál buíochas le Orla McMorrow as a cuid cabhrach chun an Halla Dealbhóireachta i nDánlann an Hugh Lane a fháil mar ionad le ceolchorim lán Ghaelach ar an 13ú Márta ag a haon a chloig. Beidh sé sin ceann de na buaicphointí ó thaobh imeachtaí le Seachtain na Gaeilge.

5. Stráitéis Gaeilge don Chomhairle

Dúirt Ray Yeates gur bhual an coiste (Ray Yeates, Donncha Ó Cathasaigh, Darach O' Connor agus Orla McMorrow) le chéile roimh na Nollag le plé a dhéanamh ar conas fobairt níos mó a dhéanamh ar an nGaeilge laistigh den Chomhairle. Aontaíodh go mba chóir dóibh straitéis dhearfach a chruthú agus chun é a chur le chéile. Beidh orthu dul i gcumarsáid lena geallsealbhóirí i ngach Róinn den Chomhairle chomh maith le Gaeilgeoirí na Cathrach agus na Comhairleoirí iad féin. Is mian leo duine a fhostú chun an próiséas idir gabhála seo seo a chur i gcrích. Róinn siad cáipéis leis an bhfochoiste a thugann imlíne agus míniú ar an gcur chuige seo.

Dúirt Orla McMorrow go bhfuil an dréacht straitéis an-soláir agus gurb í an chéad chéim sa phróiséas agus má bhíonn siad sásta leis an dréachtcháipéis seo mhol sí dóibh duine a earcú chomh luaithe is féidir chun an straitéis a tharraingt le chéile.

Bhí plé ansin maidir le fad an straitéis agus aontaíodh gur straitéis trí bliana a bhí i gceist. Mhol an Comhairleoir Ó Muirí go mbeadh sé tábhachtach daoine eile a aithint laistigh den Chomhairle chun páirt a ghlaicadh sa phróiseas seo ón túis. D'aontaigh Orla McMorrow leis an gComhairleoir Ó Muirí agus leag sí amach príomhaidhmeanna na cáipé: Reachtaíocht agus an Comhairle féin, cá bhfuilimid faoi láthair maidir le Gaeilge, na seirbhísí atá ar fáil do Ghaeilgeoirí na Cathrach. Dúirt sí nach bhfaighimid freagraí na gceisteanna sin gan iniúchadh iomlán a dhéanamh ar an staid reatha.

Mhol an Cathaoirleach go mbeadh spriocdháta ann don straitéis chun go mbeidh sé ullamh le cur ar aghaidh chuig an Chomhairle nua in 2024. Mhol sé fréisin gur fiú machnamh ar thréimhse 5 bliana don staitéis, rud a ritheadh i gcomhar le tréimhse an Chomhairle nua sin.

Dúirt Ray Yeates go mbeadh orthu tairiscint a dhéanamh don duine nó comhlacht a fhostú agus go mba chóir dul chuig an SPC go hoifigúil chun a chur in iúl dóibh go bhfuil straitéis á lorg againn.

6. Baillraíocht breise don Fhochoiste Gaeilge

D'íarr an Cathaoirleach le ainmeacha do bhallraíocht breise don Fhochoiste Gaeilge. D'ainmnigh an Comhairleoir Heney, Deirdre Ní Raghallaigh mar bhall breise agus d'ainmigh Orla McMorrow Anne-Marie Kelly ó Sheirbhísí Leabharlainne. Bhí plé ginearálta faoin bhallraíocht bhereise agus ar cheart go mbeadh sé buan. Mhol Ray Yeats macnamh ar an mbunracht atá ag an bhfochoiste, agus teacht ar tuiscint ar cad atá de dhíth, ionadaíocht ó na Roinn éagsúla nó an bhfuilimid ag lorg ionadaí deonacha ó oifigigh éagsúla? Mhol an Cathaoirleach nach mbeadh an fochoiste ró-mhór. Mhol sé cuireadh a thabhairt chuig Na Leabharlanna ionadaí a chur ar fáil agus cuireadh a sheoladh chuig Deirdre Ní Raghallaigh.

7. Aon ghno eile

Bhí plé maidir le cé comh minic go mba chóir don fhochoiste teacht le chéile - gach mí nó gach dhá mhí. Aontaíodh go mbeadh cruinnithe míosúla níos fearr. Chuir an Comhairleoir ceist faoin Oíche Shóisialta le daoine ag obair sa Chomhairle a bhfuil suim acu i nGaeilge agus le Comhairleoirí freisin. Aontaíodh gur smaoineamh maith é agus mhol an Cathaoirleach gur chóir é a bheith ar siúl tar éis Sheachtain na Gaeilge i mí Aibreán nó mí Bealtaine.

- 1. Minutes** – The minutes were agreed
- 2. Matters arising from the minutes** – all matters on the Agenda
- 3. Lá Mór na Gaeilge 2023 -**

Micheál Ó Nualláin said that the steering committee is meeting on a fortnightly basis in relation to Lá Mór na Gaeilge. This year's event will not be significantly bigger than last year's event but the Teacher's Club will be an additional venue. It is the 130th year anniversary of the Gaelic Revival and will be the theme for Lá Mór na Gaeilge this year. A person has been designated to work on an Emergency Management Plan and to liaise with the Gardaí on the day. Micheál has been in contact with the Gaelscoileanna and Gaelcholáistí to let them know about the event. They are thinking of organising an art competition and hope to display these artworks in the Hugh Lane Gallery, further to permission from the gallery. There are plans for a talent show with participation from the Gaelscoileanna and a 'Battle of the Bands' for the Gaelcholáistí also taking place, with preliminary rounds taking place in advance. They are also consulting with people in the arts with regard to curating additional events on the day.

Cllr. Heney requested a copy of the draft programme and there was a discussion regarding events for Lá Mór na Gaeilge, as well as recommendations for street performers from Cllr. Ring. Micheál Ó Nualláin said that the Clown 'Giggles' would be performing for the event.

Micheál confirmed that the Gaelic Revival would be the main theme with an emphasis on multiculturalism and new Irish citizens. Cllr. Heney mentioned that there is a Ukrainian priest in Donnycarney who speaks Irish and Micheál said he would make contact with him.

The Chair shared a letter from Des Geraghty who is seeking funding to stage a performance in Liberty Hall. He has a collection of Irish songs about Dublin. Ray Yeates said that he would contact him to discuss the matter further. Cllr. Ring suggested that Des Geraghty could submit an application for funding to him, as Liberty Hall is situated in the Central Area, in the event that there is discretionary funding available.

4. BÁC le Gaeilge:

Micheál Ó Nualláin spoke about the support packages available for businesses using Irish. He said there is a budget of ten thousand euro available towards advertising Irish or towards the development of Irish on the website. They are gathering images for the website and they will be meeting with the businesses engaging with the media. There are 35 businesses taking part with different levels of fluency in Irish. Further to Lá Mór na Gaeilge they will be launching a new support scheme for classes and/or workshops in customer service skills that will be available for free. In addition to this they are working on Seachtain na Gaeilge. Micheál thanked Orla McMorrow for her help in securing the Sculpture Hall in the Hugh Lane Gallery as a venue for a concert in Irish on the 13th March at 1pm. This will be one of the highlights of Seachtain na Gaeilge events.

5. Irish Strategy for the Council

Ray Yeates said that the committee (Ray Yeates, Donncha Ó Cathasaigh, Darach O'Connor and Orla McMorrow) met before Christmas to discuss how best to further develop Irish within the Council. It was agreed that a positive strategy should be created. They will need to engage with stakeholders in each Department of the Council, as well as Gaeilgeoirí in the city and the Councillors themselves. They would like to contract a person to start this process. They have already shared a document with the subcommittee that provides an outline and explanation of the proposed approach.

Orla McMorrow said that the draft strategy is very clear and that it is the first step in the process. If they are satisfied with this draft document, she recommended that a person should be contracted as soon as possible to put together a strategy.

There was a discussion around the duration of the strategy and it was agreed that a three year strategy was most suitable. Cllr. Murray recommended that it would be important to identify other people within the Council to participate in the process from the beginning. Orla McMorrow agreed with Cllr. Murray and set out the main goals of the document: Legislation and the Council, Where are now in relation to Irish, the services that are available to Gaeilgeoirí in the city. She said that we won't have the answers to these questions without a full audit of the current state.

The Chair advised that there should be a deadline for the strategy in order that it is in place for the new Council members in 2024. He also proposed a 5 year term for the strategy, one that would run concurrently with the Council term. Ray Yeates said that they would need to go to tender to contract the new individual/organisation and would also need to bring this to the SPC in advance to advise them about the proposed strategy.

6. Additional membership of the subcommittee

The Chair requested nominations for additional membership of the Irish Language subcommittee. Cllr. Heney recommended Deirdre Ní Raghallaigh from the Chief Executive's Officer and Orla McMorrow recommended Anne-Marie Kelly from Libraries. There was a general discussion regarding additional membership on the subcommittee and reaching an understanding of what is required, membership from various departments or are we looking for voluntary members from various departments? The Chair recommended that the subcommittee not be too large and the sending of invitations to Anne-Marie Kelly and Deirdre Ní Raghallaigh.

7. AOB

There was a discussion with regard to how often the subcommittee should meet – monthly or bi-monthly. It was agreed that monthly meetings were preferable. Cllr. Heney queried whether there would be a Social Evening for Council employees and Councillors with interest in Irish. It was agreed that this is a good idea and the Chair recommended that an event should take place after 'Seachtain na Gaeilge' in April or May.
