The Transport Advisory Group does not recommend installing Double Yellow Lines on both sides of the road as this would remove on-street parking and aggravate the issue of parking in the area. In order for Dublin City Council to consider installing a Pay & Display & Permit parking scheme, 35% or greater of residents on the road need to be in favour of a scheme. The width of Comeragh Road will allow for the installation of one-sided parking scheme and therefore, double yellow lines will be required on the opposite side of the road. The Government of Ireland Traffic Signs Manual, Section 7.9, states that certain criteria must be met before a Yellow Box can be provided. The traffic flow at this location does not meet the criteria for a Yellow Box. It is also not recommended to install 'Residents Only' parking. There is no provision under the Road Traffic Act or Road Traffic (Traffic & Parking) Regulations, for private parking on a public road. If the residents of Walkinstown Parade want to deter non-residential and commuter parking, they can apply to Dublin City Council for a Pay & Display and Permit parking scheme. Please note that at least 35% of residents on the road would need to be in favour of a scheme and provide written evidence of such, in the form of written requests or a signed ballot, to Dublin City Council.
