

Monthly Local Fund Statement

Background

Attached for consideration by the Elected Members in this July 2023 Council Agenda is the Local Fund Statement for the period 29th April 2023 to 26th of May 2023. Information is provided on:

- Monthly receipts and payments for current period and same period last year.
- Cumulative receipts and payments for current year and last year.
- Details of main receipting areas and receipts over €1m for the current month and same period last year.
- Details of payroll payments and non-pay payments over €1m in the current month and same period last year.

Overview

Over the period 29^{th} April 2023 to 26^{th} of May 2023. Dublin City Council made payments to the value of \in 147.8m. Dublin City Council receipted \in 114.6m of funds with a surplus of payments over receipts of \in 33.2m moving to a net debit balance at period end of \in 61.6m. This value of is \in 61.6m is the maximum value applicable, as it includes the full value of payments made whether cashed or not. As at 26/05/2023 Dublin City Council had placed \in 399.5m on investment. The net transfer *to* investments and refundable deposits was \in 1.5m.

There were 4 weeks in May 2023 and 4 weeks in May 2022.

Receipts

During the period Dublin City Council receipted €114.6m.

€46.8m was receipted from the Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage during the period as follow

- €9.7m for Homeless Expenditure Recoup Section 10 Q1 2023
- €32.5m for Homeless Expenditure Recoup Section 10 Q2 2023
- €1.1m for Homeless Expenditure Recoup Section 10 Covid Q1 2023
- €1.1m for RAS Rents March 2023

€4.3m was receipted from the other local authorities during the period including:

- South Dublin County Council €1.9m for April for Dublin Fire Brigade
- Fingal County Council €2.1m for April for Dublin Fire Brigade

€2.6m was receipted for Parking Meter Fees, the number of days cash collection and tags and mobiles included for 2023 are greater than 2022 reflected in higher 2023 values, €1.3m was receipted for Development Levies and €3.3m was receipted for Irish Water, one additional pay period included in 2023 values.

€5.9m was receipted from Dublin Waste to Energy Ltd for Dividend Payable to the 4 Dublin Local Authorities – Q1 2023

€4.4m was receipted from IPB Insurance CLG for Members Commercial Dividend 2021/2022

€1m was receipted from ESB for Entry Year Levy on Fitzwilliam Street Lower, Dublin 2

€29.5m was receipted for Rates, the number of rate accounts on Direct Debit has been restored to pre pandemic levels, €7.4m was receipted for Housing Rents and €1.7m for Housing Loans.
