The engineer observed that there are non-goods vehicles parking in the loading bay. In accordance with the Road Traffic (Traffic & Parking) Regulations, 1997, Article 42 (1) & (2), it is illegal for a non-goods vehicle to park in a loading bay. A goods vehicle is allowed to load and unload in a loading bay for 30 minutes. The Transport Advisory Group does not recommend installing a single yellow line on the road outside No. 127 Tyrconnell Park, as it is not current policy of Dublin City Council to install a single yellow line at a junction as the prohibition already exists in law. The Transport Advisory Group has notified Dublin Street Parking Services of illegal parking on Tyrconnell Park, D8 and requested them to enforce penalties. If the Customer continues to observe illegal parking, the Customer should contact Dublin Street Parking Services (www.dsps.ie) by e-mail at info@dsps.ie or by calling 01 602 2500. Not Recommended	The issue of goods vehicles ignoring the 3.5 tonne limit signs or speeding over speed ramps is not dealt with by the Transport Advisory Group. The appropriate signage is in place on Chapelizod Main Street at the junction of Chapelizod Road/Chapelizod Main Street. Heavy Goods Vehicles are legally allowed to enter a road if they are delivering goods or services. However, if HGVs are using the road as a thoroughfare, then entry is illegal.
