#### Waste Management and Illegal Dumping

There were 224 incidents of illegal dumping recorded on Citizen Hub for June. There were 80 Community Clean Ups for the month of June which are serviced by our Waste Management Team

### Graffiti removal 1st- 30th June

There were 9 reported cases of Graffiti in Ballymun and Finglas, 91 sq. Meters of Graffiti have been removed in North West Area.

To date 782 sq. meters of Graffiti has been removed during the period of January 2023 to June 2023.

# **IBAL June report 2023**



Ballymun: 30th out of 40 towns / cities surveyed. Moderately Littered Ballymun has moved from 31st to 30th place since last IBAL report.

A strong performance by Ballymun with notable improvements at some formerly heavily littered sites e.g., Ballymun Green Car Park. There was a lot of evidence of community initiatives e.g., Better Ballymun posters / Trinity Comprehensive school poetry project / Climate themed Traffic Light Box Art / Trinity Comprehensive History Trail and Tidy Towns sponsored planter boxes. Ballymun Road and Ballymun Town Centre were very much deserving of the top litter grade. The two most heavily littered sites have been causing issues for many years – Balbutcher Lane and the Bring Facility at Shangan Road.

#### **Griffith Road laneway**

Recently the Public Domain Unit with the support of residents cleaned the laneway at Griffith Road. The façade metal railings and gates where regenerated and painted.
