## Mountjoy - Garda Report

### Crime Prevention Matters and Other Information

779 patrols undertaken in the Mountjoy District from 1<sup>st</sup> of April to 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2023 (1000 in U District in total). This involves Gardaí in high visibility clothing patrolling the areas on the beat, pedal cycle and patrol vehicles.
