Central Area Public Domain Environmental Services Report North Inner City & Cabra Glasnevin Area

Litter Hotline/Citizens Hub

In the period 1^{st} July -31^{st} August 2023, incidents were reported via Litter Hotline/Citizens HUB for the **North Inner City & Cabra Glasnevin Area**.

In addition to the CRM & Citizens Hub incidents, the Public Domain crew for the North Inner City & Glasnevin / Cabra Area carry out inspections of their assigned routes on a daily basis. They collect any dumped bags/materials found, that is not always reflected on the above figures.

The total tonnage of collected illegally dumped items from our four vehicles was:

• **36.25 tonne** for August 2023 and **38.14 tonne** for July. This brings the total for this year to **314.82** tonne.

Community Clean-ups

Community Clean-up equipment was distributed to 19 Community Groups / individuals between 1^{st} July -31^{st} August. Requests for the removal of bags from community clean ups were handled by Waste Management and Public Domain staff.




Map 1 – Mainly the Cabra & Phisborough area. This was all treated between 8th Aug & 15th Aug.
