


## **Construction Phase**

- Circet (Ireland) Ltd. was appointed as main contractor for the works
- Construction commenced on 17<sup>th</sup> April on Temple Bar Square
- Phase 1 included
  - Removal of the existing paving, steps and underlying slab
  - Construction of tree pits
  - Installation of public lighting cabling
  - Re-profiling the Square to gently fall from south to north
  - Installation of new paving
- Phase 1 was completed at the end of August

# **Construction Phase**

- Phase 2 involved paving works along the southern building line on Temple Bar Square and was completed on the 20<sup>th</sup> of September
- Phase 3 involves paving along the northern and eastern side of Temple Bar Square and construction of drainage infrastructure
- Phase 3 works have required a minor diversion in vehicular traffic across the Square
- The art piece is currently in transit after being fabricated in the UK and is due for installation shortly





## Next Steps

- Construction work on the central section of Temple Bar Square (excluding Fownes St Lower) is expected be completed before the end of 2023
- This will include installation of public lighting columns and benches and tree planting
- Upon completion of works on the Square, the works will move sequentially onto Crown Alley and Temple Bar Street
- Construction will take approximately 18-24 months
- Some road closures will be required to facilitate the works. Alternative delivery arrangements will be made during road closures
- Access to all buildings within the site will be maintained throughout the works
