Martin Savage Park

At the July 2023 Central Area Committee, we reported our intention to initiate in the autumn a Part 8 planning consultation for improvements to Martin Savage Park which will include inter alia an all weather /astro surface 130m x70m; a childrens playground; floodlighting of the senior grass GAA pitch; widening and public lighting of the pavement which parallels the railway to provide a 'Share with Care' pedestrian/cycle route.

Reports from consultants are still being collated and there is an on-going consultation with other departments of Dublin City Council to validate the information and to inform the final proposals and plan. This process will be completed shortly and the Part 8 will be initiated at the November Central Area Committee meeting.

This short delay in the pre-planning process will have no impact on the timeline for construction in 2024 subject of course to the approval by Council of the Part 8.
