# Central Area Public Domain Report North Inner City & Glasnevin / Cabra Area

#### **Litter Hotline/Citizens Hub**

In the period  $1^{st} - 28^{th}$  September 2023, incidents were reported via Litter Hotline/Citizens HUB for the **North Inner City & Glasnevin / Cabra Area**.

In addition to the CRM & Citizens Hub incidents, the Public Domain crew for the North Inner City & Glasnevin / Cabra Area carry out inspections of their assigned routes on a daily basis. They collect any dumped bags/materials found, that is not always reflected on the above figures.

The total tonnage of collected illegally dumped items from our four vehicles was:

• **46.36 tonne** for September. This brings the total for this year to **361.18** tonne.

#### **NEIC Community Clean-ups**

Community Clean-up equipment was distributed to  $\underline{14}$  Community Groups / individuals between  $1^{st} - 30^{th}$  September. Requests for the removal of bags from community clean ups were handled by Waste Management and Public Domain staff.

#### **Graffiti Removal**






#### **Bring Centres, Central Area**

At present we have one Recycling Centre (aka Civic Amenity Site) on Shamrock Terrace, North Strand. We also have one Bring Centre in Grangegorman, which accepts mixed dry recyclables (paper, plastic, cardboard, tetrapak), glass bottles/jars, aluminium cans, WEEEE, and textiles free of charge and green (garden) waste at €2 per bag (up to 80L) or €16 per skip bag.

Central Area also contains a number of unmanned bring bank sites, i.e. bottle/clothes banks, located at East Wall Road, Chancery Street, Phibsborough Shopping Centre, Tesco Prussia Street, St. Finbarr's GAA Club, Breffni Inn Ashtown, and St. Oliver Plunkett's GAA Club.

## **Halloween**


A dedicated Cabra/Glasnevin Halloween response team will be operational to identify and coordinate the removal of bonfire material from the area.

## St Peters Lane Clean-up

Contractor was engaged to clear St Peters Lane off Cabra Park. This laneway is well used with access to the Cabra Road. Over time the laneway had become an illegal dumping site with the Cabra Office receiving various complaints of antisocial behaviour.



## Painting Programme Cabra/Glasnevin

Phibsborough and Carnlough Road were identified in the first stage of the Cabra/Glasnevin painting programme with a total of 240 bollards and bins painted in Phibsborough and 66 lighting poles on Carnlough Road.
