

With reference to a proposal to initiate the procedure for the Extinguishment of the Public Right of Way over the laneway at St. Marys Terrace, Dorset Street, Dublin 1.

Proposal

A request to have the public right of way extinguished over the lane at St. Mary's Terrace, Dorset Street, Dublin 1 has been made. The Housing Department have requested the extinguishment of the public right-of-way as part of the redevelopment of Dorset Street / St. Mary's Place Flats.

The improved interface with surrounding areas will contribute to local regeneration and supports the Council's strategic regeneration policies relating to the Civic Spine, Parnell Square Cultural Quarter and the Grangegorman campus. The extent of this proposed extinguishment is shown outlined in red on the attached map Index No.SM 2023-0225.

The Central Area Committee, at its meeting on the 18th April 2023, agreed to initiate the statutory procedure to extinguish the public right of way over this laneway under the provisions of Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993.

Statutory

By public advertisement on the 2nd May 2023, representations or objections were invited by the 21st June 2023. The site notice at this location was erected on the 2nd May 2023.

No objections were received.

Service Check

A service check has been carried out and no service provider will need to alter the current services on or under or over that part of the referred lane. Accessibilities arrangements, for such service providers, shall be made through the Central Area Office or those private customers that are engaged with that service provider(s).


Recommendation

I recommend that the extinguishment of the public right of way over the area shown on Map SM-2023-0225 be approved by the City Council. The extinguishment of a public right of way is a function reserved to the City Council.

Resolution

That We, the Lord Mayor and Members of Dublin City Council, being the Roads Authority for the City of Dublin and being of the opinion that the public right of way over the laneway at St. Marys Terrace, Dorset Street, Dublin 1 as shown on the attached Drawing SM 2023-0225 is no longer required for public use, extinguish the public right of way in accordance with Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993.
