Students can be redirected by school management to a safe crossing point on Collins Avenue junction with Falcarragh Road/Larkhill Road, where a controlled pedestrian crossing is in place near the second school gates on Falcarragh Road. | Member of the Public | 10/05/2023 | 15 |
| 2 | 7036038 | Yellow Box (Extend) | CLONTARF ROAD (NC) | Dublin 3 | Extend yellow box across both lanes on inward side and entrance to West Wood Club, to ensure safety of pedestrians and cyclists. | Not Recommended | Clontarf Road near West Wood Club is being upgraded as part of the DCC's ActiveTravel: Clontarf to City Centre Project, Cycling & Walking Scheme. As part of this scheme, a review of the current infrastructure will be carried out to determine the most appropriate way to make this route safer. | 4 | 7036091 | Double Yellow Lines | COLLINS AVENUE (NC) | Dublin 9 | Double yellow lines in front of the houses in question. | Not Recommended | It is not recommended to install parking restrictions, such as placing double yellow lines across driveways, where restrictions are already covered under the law. Under The Road Traffic (Traffic & Parking) Regulations, Section 36 paragraph (2); A vehicle shall not be parked: (g) in any place, position or manner that will result in the vehicle obstructing an entrance or an exit for vehicles to or from a premises, save with the consent of the occupier of such premises; Any instances of illegal parking (blocking school gates/parking on the pavement) should be reported to the Gardai or Dublin Street Parking Services (tel no. 01 602-2500) or email: info@dpsps.ie for enforcement under the current Road Traffic Regulations. | Councillor | 09/11/2023 | 0 |

Vehicles were observed exiting/entering the estate without any difficulty. It is therefore, not recommended to install Traffic signals at the above location. | Member of the Public | 20/10/2023 | 0 |

| 11 | 11145886 | Double Yellow Lines | VERNON HEATH (NC) | Dublin 3 | request Double yellow lines. | Not Recommended | Under the Road Traffic Regulations, traffic on a road ending at a T junction must give way to traffic from either direction on the main road and the road may only continue if it is safe to do. On-street parking reduces speeds and improves driver caution acting as a form of traffic calming. Implementation or extending of parking restrictions at the above location would not only remove parking amenity but also contribute to an increase in speed on the road in accordance with Design Manual for Urban Roads and Streets guidelines. | 12 | 11146066 | Roundabout | GRIFFITH AVENUE (NC) | Dublin 3 | re traffic lights timing, remove them and have a roundabout instead. | Not Recommended | The Dublin City Council's policy is to promote and prioritise pedestrian movements, cyclists and public transport over private car users. The Transport Advisory Group does not recommend replacing signalised traffic junctions with roundabouts or removing cycle lines. However, the matter will be referred to DCC's Intelligent Traffic Systems (ITS) Section to review the current traffic light sequencing arrangements and ensure that adequate time is allowed to ensure the safety of road users during all phases of the traffic light sequence. | Member of the Public | 24/10/2023 | 0 |

| 16 | 11146269 | Double Yellow Lines | BRIARFIELD VILLAS (NC) | Dublin 5 | request Installation of double yellow lines to stop parking. | Not Recommended | <p>Briarfield Villas was previously investigated following numerous requests for the introduction of parking restrictions.</p> <p>A School Keep Clear road marking is provided at the entrance of ABACAS Special School for 26 metres, and a second one, provided opposite side at the entrance to St.Michael's House.</p> <p>These parking restriction combined with the staggered vehicular parking acts as a traffic calming measures by physically narrowing the width of the carriageway. Further restrictions on this section of the road would lead to increased traffic speeds, whereas parking tends to have a calming effect helping to slow down the traffic in accordance with Design Manual for Urban Roads and Streets guidelines.</p> <p>Under The Road Traffic (Traffic & Parking) Regulations, Section 36 paragraph (2); a vehicle shall not be parked:</p> <p>(a) on that side of a section of roadway along the edge of which traffic sign number RRM 008 [double yellow lines] has been provided;</p> <p>(c) within 5 metres of a road junction;</p> <p>(i) on a footway, a grass margin or a median strip;</p> <p>(k) in a manner in which it will interfere with the normal flow of traffic or which obstructs or endangers other traffic;</p> <p>Any instances of illegal parking (blocking school gates/parking on the pavement) should be reported to the Gardai or Dublin Street Parking Services (tel no. 01 602-2500) or email: info@dps.ie for enforcement under the current Road Traffic Regulations.</p> | Councillor | 26/10/2023 | 1 |
