#### b Housing - Cllr Alison Gilliland

Cllr Gilliland issues the following written update:

The Housing SPC met on Wednesday 13th September. We explored current approaches to maximising vacancy for residential opportunities including understanding current levels of unactivated planning permissions for residential development and harnessing these as potential partnerships and the adaptive reuse programme which commenced last autumn when the government's urban regeneration development fund was established. This programme is working extremely well and has the potential not only to increase residential offerings of social housing in the core city centre but also to bring vacant building back to productive use.

We were also informed at our meeting that the Minister had approved our proposed Scheme of Priorities for Affordable Purchase homes for the DCC area which was agreed by the July SPC. This scheme will be tabled at the November Monthly meeting for Council approval.

The next SPC meeting will be held on Wednesday 11th October and will discuss our collaboration with the LDA on cost rental developments and provide an update on our own cost rental development on Emmet Road.
