
PURPOSE OF THE LECP

OVERVIEW OF THE LECP


- LECP Framework 6 year period (2023 2028)

LECP MILESTONES 2024

Milestone 1:

Milestone 2:

Sees the completion and analysis of the Consultation and the revision of the High-level Goals Revision of high-level goals (sign off LCDC, SPC) – 31.01.2024

Milestone 3:

The third milestone sees the development of the Objectives, Outcomes and Actions Indicative date for completion W/C 18th March 2024

Milestone 4:

The final milestone sees the development and submission of the LECP Framework and initial Implementation Plan for final approval
