## Monthly Local Fund Statement

### Background

Attached for consideration by the Elected Members in this February 2024 Council Agenda is the Local Fund Statement for the period *01<sup>st</sup> January to 26<sup>th</sup> January 2024*. Information is provided on:

- Monthly receipts and payments for current period and same period last year.
- Cumulative receipts and payments for current year and last year.
- Details of main receipting areas and receipts over €1m for the current month and same period last year.
- Details of payroll payments and non-pay payments over €1m in the current month and same period last year.

### Overview

Over the period  $01^{st}$  January to  $26^{th}$  January 2024 Dublin City Council made payments to the value of  $\in 170.8$ m. Dublin City Council receipted  $\in 86$ m of funds with a deficit of receipts over payments of  $\in 84.8$ m moving to a net debit balance at period end of  $\in 74$ m. This value of is  $\in 74$ m is the maximum value applicable, as it includes the full value of payments made whether cashed or not. As at 26/01/2024 Dublin City Council had placed  $\in 315.05$ m on investment. The net transfer *from* investments and refundable deposits was  $\in 32.5$ m.

There were 4 weeks in January 2023 and 4 weeks in January 2024.

### **Receipts**

During the period Dublin City Council receipted €86m.

€19.9m was receipted from the Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage during the period including €19.8m for Homeless Expenditure Recoup Section 10 – Q1 2024

€2.3m was receipted from the other local authorities during the period including South Dublin County Council – €1.9m for December 2023 Dublin Fire Brigade Contribution

€2.1m was receipted for Parking Meter Fees and €1.5m was receipted for Uisce Éireann. In 2023 the previous year balancing invoice was paid in February, in 2024 the previous balancing invoice has been paid in January. €1.8m was receipted from the Department of Rural and Community Development, for SICAP Q1 2024.

€9.4m was receipted for Rates, € 8.4m was receipted for Housing Rents and €2m was receipted for Housing Loans. The 2024 Housing Rents value includes six weeks direct debts while the 2023 values include four weeks.

# Payments

During the period Dublin City Council made payments to the value of €170.8m. €19.6m was paid to Contractors as follows:

- €1.6m to George V Maloney & Co Solicitors Purchase of Local Authority Housing Stock Deposits and Balances of 5 units in D3, D11, D12.
- €9m to John Sisk & Sons Construction and refurbishment of Cork Street & Bonham Street.
- Q1 Funding 2024 to the Homeless Voluntary Bodies Crosscare €1.7m, The Salvation Army €2m, DePaul Trust Ireland €1.5m, Focus Ireland €1.3m,
- €2.5m to Energia DCC electricity costs. The 2024 payment relates to billing periods Nov/Dec 2023 and Dec/Jan 2024 while the 2023 payment related to Dec/Jan 2023 only.

€22.7m was paid in respect of HFA Loan Redemptions – Bi Annual Loan Repayments, Principal and Interest.
