

## PART 8 NOTIFICATION – Floodlighting Provision Donore Harriers Athletic Track.

## **FOR NOTING**

Dublin City Council has developed proposals for the installation of floodlighting for Donore Harriers Athletics Track in Liffey Valley Park, Chapelizod. It is our intention to lodge Part 8 proposals in the coming weeks and therefore notify the Area Committee of this now. The purpose of the proposed flood lighting is to upgrade the existing sports facilities to ensure the availability of, and equal access to sporting facilities for local populations. This proposal also represents a significant investment by Sports Capital Grants and Dublin City Council.

Parks, Biodiversity and Landscape Services propose to install 5 number new floodlight columns with 2/3 no. LED fittings depending on the location of each column at the existing running track at Donore Harriers Athletic Club, Liffey Valley Park.



The development provides an adequate amount of light while balancing safety, amenity and environmental considerations. The lighting will enhance the level of lighting on the track and will make it safe for training in winter evenings and provide the correct level of illumination for athletics training to be conducted. The operating hours for the floodlights will be dusk to 10pm. Both an Appropriate Assessment Screening and an Environmental Impact Assessment Screening have been carried out and concluded that due to the nature, scale and location of the proposal that no significant effects are likely and so no EIA, EIAR or AA is required.
