Rather than provide double yellow lines on the south side of Upper Cross Road, a continuous white line extending from the new stop line will be provided. This will prohibit parking on both sides of the continuous white line. Under Road Traffic (Traffic and Parking) Regulations 1997 section 36:2:d "A vehicle shall not be parked - on a section of roadway with less than 3 traffic lanes and where traffic sign number RRM 001 [continuous white line] has been provided;" Instances of illegal or obstructive parking should be referred to Dublin Street Parking Services, DSPS (email info@dspd.ie or tel. no. 01 602 2500) or an Garda Síochána for enforcement.
