| 2    | 11140235 | Yield Sign           | THOMAS COURT (SC)      | Dublin 8  | request a yield sign to be installed and the painted symbol on the road to be repainted.                        | Not Recommended | Not recommended – the yield marking on Thomas Court was rescinded in 2019 and signage was removed. This was done because Thomas Court has right of way at this junction. As such, it is not recommended to repaint the faded yield road marking or provide a new yield sign at this location.   | Member of the Public | 29/06/2023 | 0   |
| 3    | 11140342 | No Parking           | GALTYMORE ROAD (SC)    | Dublin 12 | request traffic calming/double yellow lines.  | Not Recommended | Not recommended – following an assessment, it was found that 10 no. speed cushions and 3 no. speed ramps have been provided along Galtymore Road. These measures are considered sufficient and no changes are recommended at this time.<br>Parking restrictions were recently provided along Galtymore Road to allow for buses to move along the road. These restrictions were balanced so as to preserve access, as well as preserving parking amenity for residents. Further restrictions at this location would inconvenience residents, shift parking elsewhere and likely lead to an increase in speeds along the road. As such, no measures are recommended at this time.<br>Additional greening and trees should be applied for through the area office. | Member of the Public | 01/07/2023 | 0   |
| 4    | 11144676 | Double Yellow Lines  | BULFIN ROAD (SC)       | Dublin 8  | Request Double yellow lines to be extended at junction of 73 Bulfin Road and 1 Anner Road Dublin 8.             | Not Recommended | Not recommended – following an assessment, no issues with regards to parking at the junction of Bulfin Road and Anner Road were observed. Double yellow lines have previously been provided to preserve visibility turning from Anner Road onto Bulfin Road. No further double yellow lines are deemed necessary in this instance.<br>Bulfin Road is wide enough to accommodate two-sided on-street parking. On-street parking has a passive traffic calming effect, helping to reduce vehicular speeds. Additional parking restrictions at this location would inconvenience residents and may lead to an increase in speeds on Bulfin Road.   | Member of the Public | 29/09/2023 | 0   |
| 5    | 11145657 | Right Turn Only      | SLIEVEBLOOM ROAD (SC)  | Dublin 12 | request right turn only out of the apartment complex.   | Not Recommended | Not recommended – Slievebloom Road, specifically the area at the entrance to the apartment block is a two-way road. Vehicles exiting the apartment block may turn left or right and as such signage or road markings banning the left turn are not recommended.   | Member of the Public | 17/10/2023 | 0   |

Yellow boxes are not provided to preserve access to private entrances. Yellow boxes are provided on road junctions where traffic volumes are high and where blocking back affecting cross-flow is a significant problem. As such, a yellow box is not recommended at this location.<br>It should be noted that under Road Traffic (Traffic and Parking) Regulations 1997 section 36:2:g "A vehicle shall not be parked - in any place, position or manner that will result in the vehicle obstructing an entrance or an exit for vehicles to or from a premises, save with the consent of the occupier of such premises;"<br>Instances of illegal or obstructive parking should be referred to Dublin Street Parking Services, DSPS (email info@dspd.ie or tel. no. 01 602 2500) or an Garda Síochána for enforcement.  | Member of the Public | 18/10/2023 | 0   |

| 8    | 11153067 | No Parking                 | NEW IRELAND ROAD (SC)        | Dublin 8 | Request parking restrictions.   | Recommended     | Following an assessment, it was not recommended to provide double yellow lines on the south side of New Ireland Road, from the junction with Herberton Road.<br>However, in their stead, a continuous centre line will be provided from the junction with Herberton Road as well as a stop sign and stop line. This will make parking opposite the continuous centre line illegal. This signage is considered sufficient. Additional signage at this location would detract from the effectiveness of the signage already in place and contribute towards a proliferation of signage throughout the city. | 15   | 11160153 | Double Yellow Lines           | TYRCONNELL PARK (SC)  | Dublin 8  | request double yellow lines at the corners.  | Not Recommended | Not recommended – it is not current policy to provide parking restrictions where restrictions are already covered under legislation. Under Road Traffic (Traffic & Parking) Regulations 1997, 36:2:c “A vehicle shall not be parked - within 5 metres of a road junction;”<br>Furthermore, it was noted that as part of a previous recommendation for a yield line at this location on Tyrconnell Park, a continuous centre line was recommended at this location. Under Road Traffic (Traffic & Parking) Regulations 1997, 36:2:d “A vehicle shall not be parked - Road on a section of roadway with less than 3 traffic lanes and where traffic sign number RRM 001 [continuous white line] has been provided;”<br>These restrictions are deemed sufficient and no further measures are recommended at this time.
