**With reference to the extinguishment of the public right of way over the laneway to the rear of houses No.3 to 15 on St. Ignatius Road, Dublin 7.**

---

### **Proposal**

A request, to have the public right of way extinguished over the laneway to the rear of houses No.3 to 15 on St. Ignatius Road, Dublin 7 was made. The reason for this extinguishment is due to illegal dumping.

The extent of this proposed extinguishment is shown outlined in red on the attached map, SM 2024-0130

The Central Area Committee, at its meeting on the 9th April 2024 agreed to initiate the statutory procedure to extinguish the public right of way over this laneway and at its meeting on the 9th July 2024 agreed to recommend the procedure to extinguish the public right of way over this laneway under the provisions of Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993.

### **Statutory**

By public advertisement on the 24<sup>th</sup> April 2024, representations or objections were invited by the 12<sup>th</sup> June 2024. The site notice at this location was erected on the 24<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

The following responses were submitted through Dublin City Councils Online Consultation Hub:

- *“Fully support this proposal. Antisocial behaviour here has increased in recent years and more needs to be done to create a safe environment.”*
- *“There is no need to extinguish the right of way. Proper enforcement of illegal dumping, increased lighting and community engagement will help discourage the problem”*

### **Service Check**

A service check has been carried out and Public Lighting will need to alter the current services on or under or over that part of the referred lane. Accessibilities arrangements, for such service providers, shall be made through the Central Area Office or those private customers that are engaged with that service provider(s).

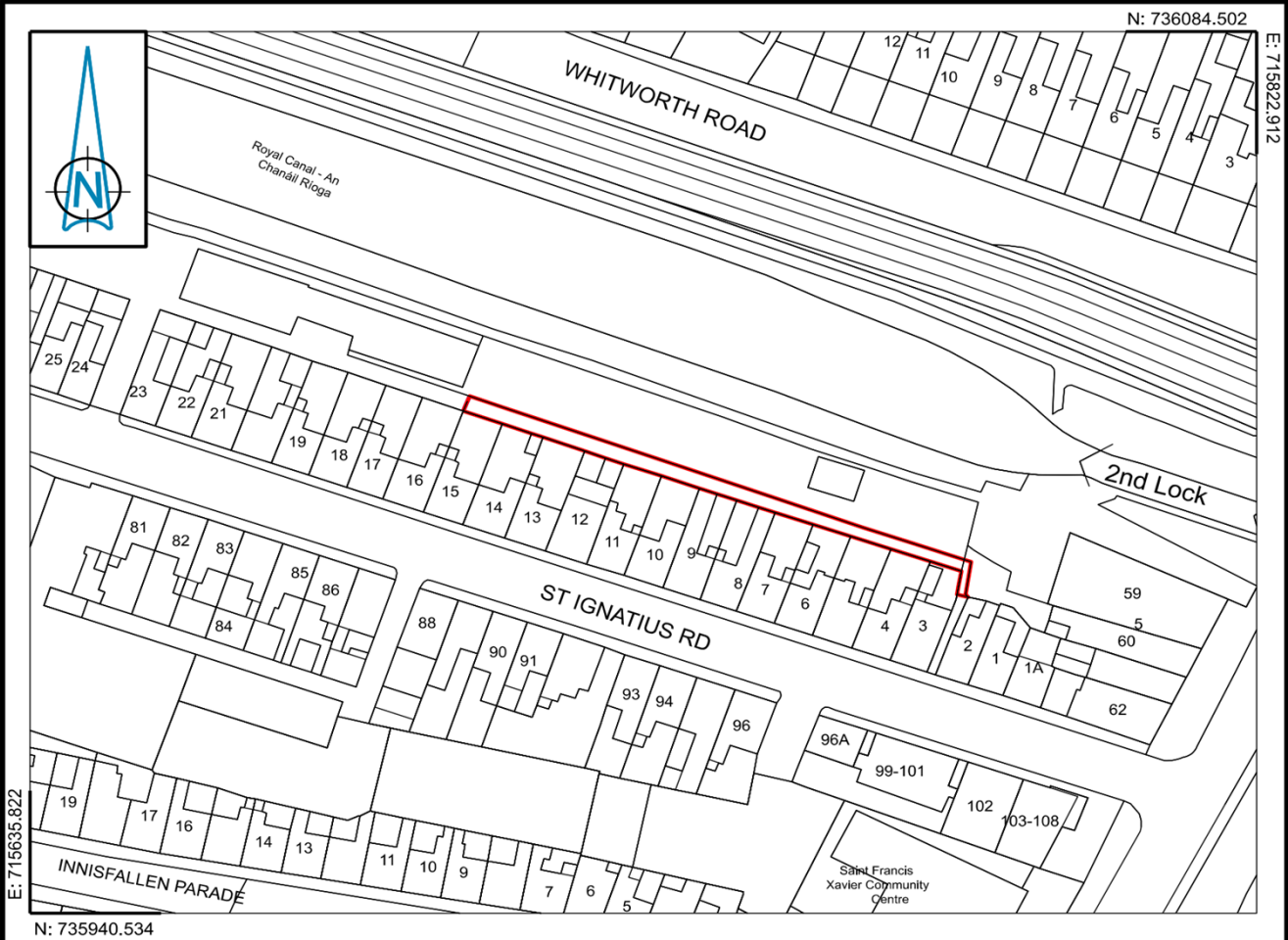
### **Recommendation**

I recommend that this Committee approve the extinguishment of the public right of way over the area shown on Map SM 2024-0130, for consideration by the City Council. The extinguishment of a public right of way is a function reserved to the City Council.

## **Resolution**

That We, the Lord Mayor and Members of Dublin City Council, being the Roads Authority for the City of Dublin and being of the opinion that the public right of way over the laneway to the rear of houses No.3 to 15 on St. Ignatius Road, Dublin 7 as shown on the attached Map SM 2024-0130 is no longer required for public use, extinguish the public right of way in accordance with Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993.
