Community Grants Scheme and Informal Adult Education Scheme 2024

Applications for financial assistance were received from a number of bodies under the City Council's Community Grants Scheme 2024 and Informal Adult Education Grant Scheme.

A total of 102 applications were received in the North West Area seeking funding of €61,261 for the Finglas area and €72,536 for the Ballymun area however only €60,000 funding was available for allocation in the North West Area.

A total of 17 applications were received for Informal Adult Education Grant Scheme in the North West Area seeking funding of €4,000 for the Finglas area and €8,380 for the Ballymun area.

The amounts allocated under the Informal Adult Education Programme are based on the number of weeks a programme runs 5, 10 or 15 weeks

These applications have been assessed in the context of available funding, value to the community and compliance with the relevant policies and objectives of the Council and in particular with relevance to the Social Inclusion Strategy.

Set out below are details of the North West Area applications together with recommendations in relation to the amount of grant assistance for each applicant.

It is recommended that Dublin City Council make the grants to the groups as set out in the report below.

There is provision in the 2024 budget to meet this expenditure.
