Dublin City Council Sláintecare Healthy Communities Programme hosted the launch of the Community Perspectives on Health Needs and Assets in Sláintecare Healthy Community Programme Areas in Dublin report.

This report was launched as part of Inclusion and Integration Week in November. The report summarises the health needs across the Dublin Sláintecare areas. The research explores community perspectives on health and wellbeing as well as community assets in the Dublin SHCP areas which includes Priorswood, Kilmore West, and Darndale. This study was commissioned by Dublin City Council.
