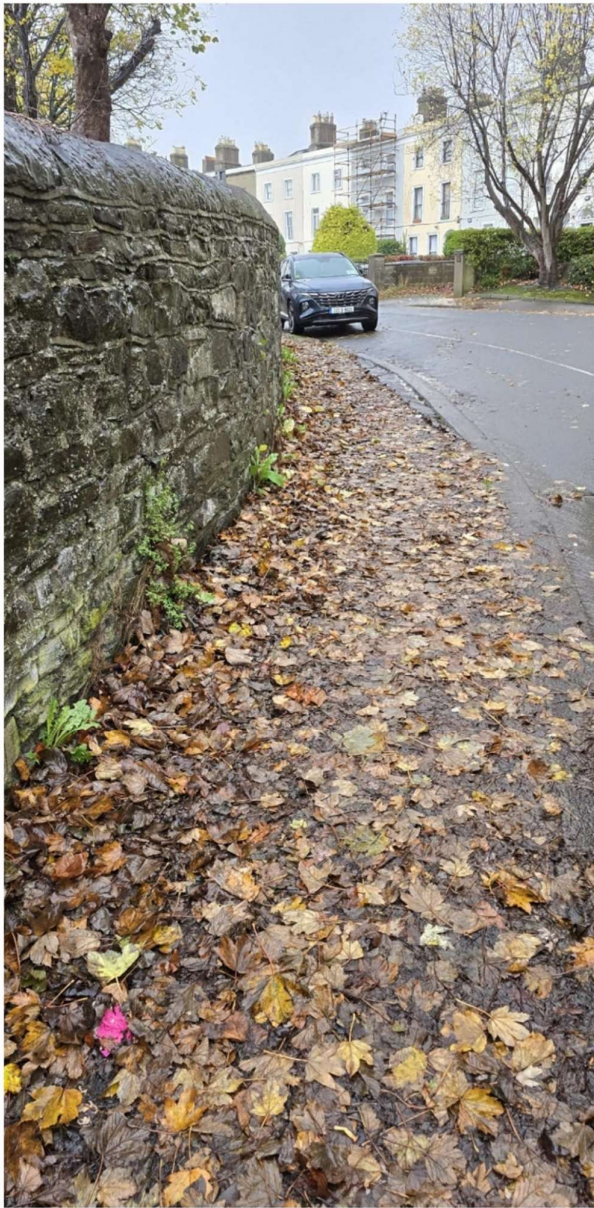
Autumn Leaves

The community leaf gathering event on Griffith Avenue took place from Saturday 16th November until Sunday 24th November 2024. The Public Domain Team, Waste Management, All Hallows Residents Association & local schools worked collaboratively to clear the leaves from the Avenue to keep it safe for everyone. Leaves from the footpaths were placed into our compostable leaf bags by residents and school children, bags were collected by the waste management crews and taken away for composting. Staff in Waste Management kept the cycle way clear.

This event was a huge success yet again.



Footpaths across the area have been cleared of fallen leaves by our Waste Management Crews in order to make them safe for members of the public.
