However, the school management was informed to redirect students to the safest crossing point at Falcarragh Road junction with Larkhill Road, where a controlled pedestrian crossing is in place near the second school entrance. There is a pedestrian crossing (traffic lights) situated about 80 meters to the east of St. Aidan's CBS, at the junction of Collins Avenue with Larkhill Road/Falcarragh Road. Furthermore, a second crossing is located around 260 meters west of the gate entrance.
