



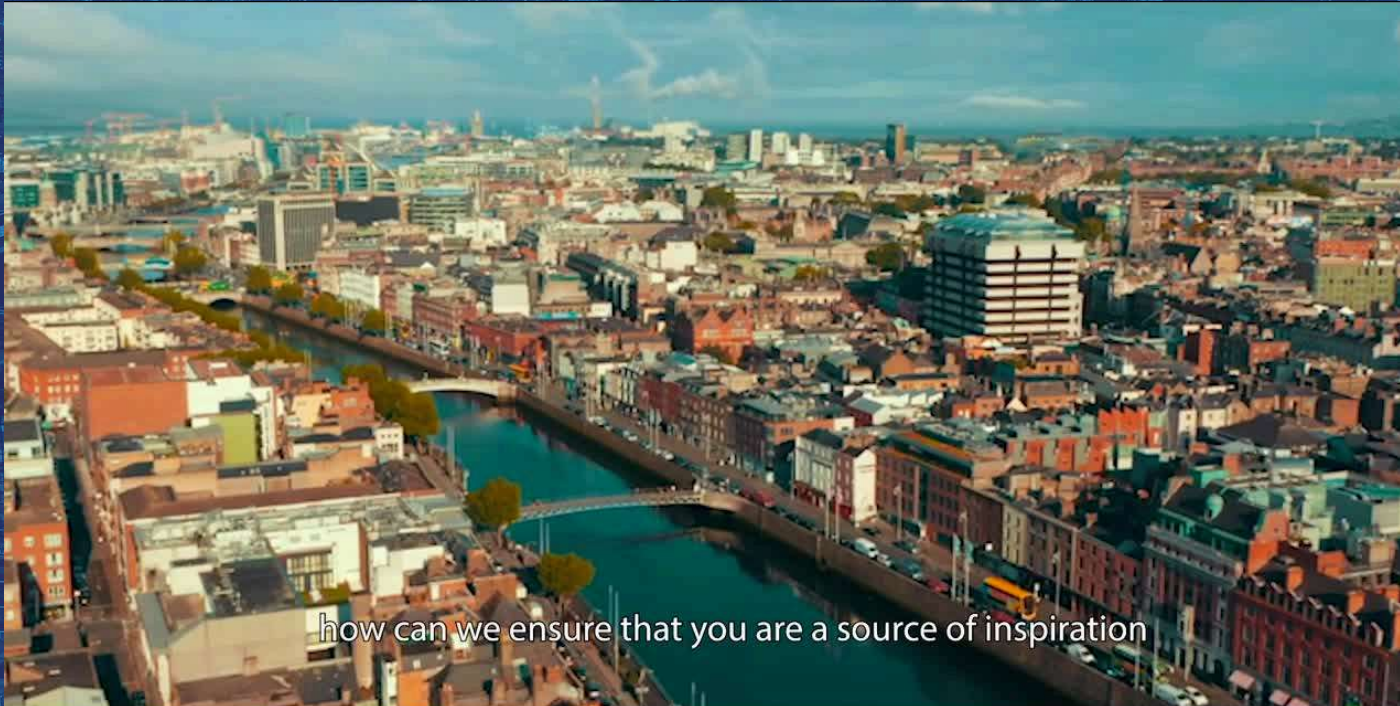

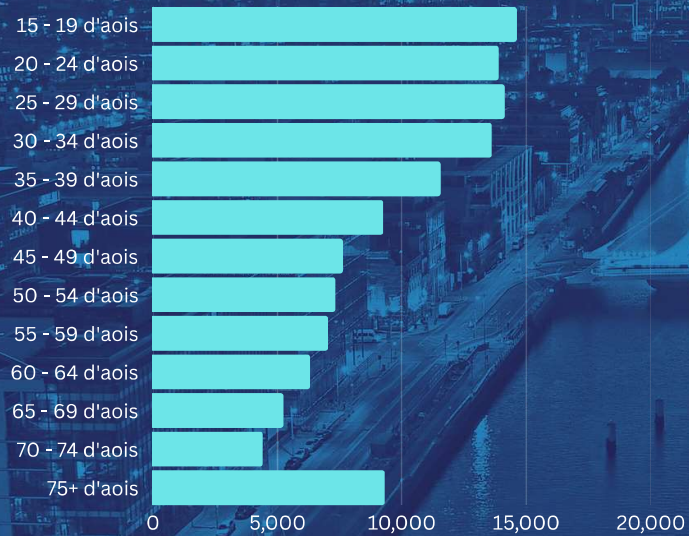

N.B. People don't have to have ideas to sign up for the mentorship sessions.

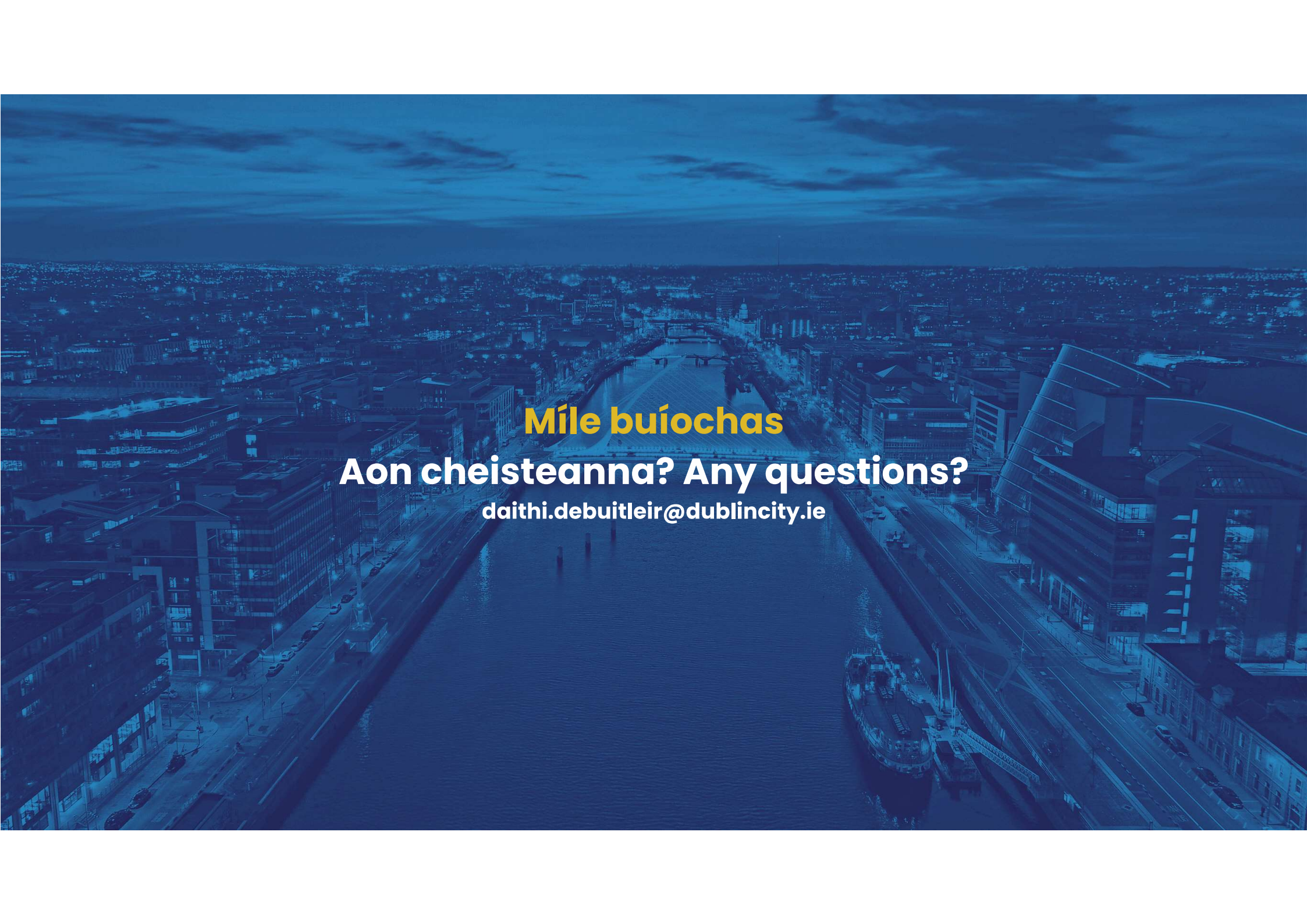
