**Order:** The Roll out of the Anti Dog Fouling Enforcement Initiative started in the North Central Area on the 12<sup>th</sup> June 2016. To date 14 Fines have been issued in the North Central Area, 13 in St. Anne's Park and 1 on Clontarf Promenade.

Four Dog Fouling Bins have been piloted in strategic positions in the North Central Area. If these prove successful in reducing the number of dog fouling incidents, an additional 40 bins will be rolled out in the North Central Area.

Chief Superintendent requested if Public Domain Team could leave a schedule with the Local Sergeant of areas they will patrol each weekend. Dog Fines success be included in the E-ZINE
