With reference to a proposal to extinguish the Public Right of Way over a stretch of roadway at Borris Court, Dublin 8

## **Proposal**

The South Central Area Committee, at its meeting on the 21<sup>st</sup> September 2016, agreed to initiate the statutory procedures to extinguish the public right of way over a stretch of roadway at Borris Court, Dublin 8. This is to facilitate the erection of lockable gates at either end of Borris Court.

The extent of the proposed extinguishment is shown on the attached **Drawing R.M** 36604

## **Statutory Requirement**

By public advertisement (Irish Times) on the 27<sup>th</sup> September 2016. Representations or objections were invited by the 8<sup>th</sup> November 2016, and 2 site notices were erected at the location.

## **Service Check**

Service providers have been informed of this proposal and their requirements will be facilitated.

## Recommendation

The South Central Area Committee, at a meeting held on the 16<sup>th</sup> November 2016, having considered a report on this proposal, agreed that the right of way be extinguished. The extinguishment of a public right of way under Section 73 of the Roads Act, 1993 is a function reserved to the City Council.

I recommend that the Lord Mayor and Members of Dublin City Council approve of the extinguishment of the public right of way over the area shown on the attached drawing R.M.36604
