Re: Litter Priorities

The Litter Management Plan 2016 – 2018 sets out objectives for preventing and managing litter in the City and how Dublin City Council aims to achieve these objectives.

Litter prevention is one of the key responsibilities of the Environment Strategic Policy Committee and I want the Committee to identify 5 focus areas for specific attention in order to achieve an improvement in these areas to complement and enhance the Litter Management Plan.

I have identified 3 areas which I believe require urgent attention and could reap benefits in the short to medium term as follows:

- Overflowing of street litter bins, particularly at weekends
- Non compliance of multi-occupancy dwellings with the Waste Bye-Laws
- Cigarette butts

We will discuss this further at our meeting on 30th November 2016 with a view to agreeing two other areas that Members of the Committee deem to be in need of priority attention.
