

With further reference to the proposed disposal of the fee simple in a site for an ESB substation at Peadar Kearney House, Railway Street, Dublin 1.

Report No. 326/2013 which was assented to by the City Council at its meeting on the 7th October 2013 contained a proposal to dispose of the fee simple in a site for a substation at Peadar Kearney House, Railway Street, Dublin 1 to the ESB as a result of Dublin City Council's Housing Department re-development of this area for social housing.

Report No. 320/2014 which was assented to by the City Council at its meeting on the 10th November 2014 changed the interest being disposed of to the ESB from fee simple to the granting of a 99 year lease for a rent of €1 per annum, if demanded.

The legal formalities have not yet been completed and the ESB has informed the Council that it is also necessary to provide them with a right of way from James Joyce Street to the location of the substation within the housing complex, as shown coloured yellow on Map Index No SM-2013-0655 Rev B, a copy of which is submitted with this report.

Accordingly, it is proposed to vary Report Nos. 326/2013 & 320/2014 in so far as they relate to the substation and to include in this disposal a right of way from James Joyce Street to the location of the substation within the housing complex. All other terms remain the same.

The area to be disposed of was acquired from Gresley Trustees, Eden Trustees and others.

The disposal shall be subject to any such covenants and conditions as the Law Agent in his discretion shall stipulate.

No agreement enforceable at law is created or intended to be created until an exchange of contracts has taken place.

This report is submitted in accordance with the requirements of Section 183 of the Local Government Act, 2001.
