# Monthly Local Fund Statement

## Background

Attached for consideration by the elected members in this March Council Agenda is the Local Fund Statement for the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2017 to 27<sup>th</sup> January 2017. This report is presented in a format agreed at the Finance SPC and noted by the City Council at its meeting in September 2011. The agreed format provides information on:

- Monthly receipts and payments for current period and same period last year.
- Cumulative receipts and payments for current year and last year.
- Details of main receipting areas and receipts over €1m for the current month and same period last year.
- Details of payroll payments and non pay payments over €1m in the current month and same period last year.

#### Overview

Over the period 1/01/17 to 27/01/17 Dublin City Council made payments to the value of  $\in$ 90.9m. Dublin City Council receipted  $\in$ 52.7m of funds with a period excess of payments over receipts of  $\in$ 38.2m moving to a net credit balance at period end of  $\in$ 14.8m. This value of  $\in$ 14.8m is the maximum value applicable, as it includes the full value of payments made whether cashed or not. As at 27/01/2016 Dublin City Council had placed  $\in$ 105.8m on investment.

### Receipts

During the period Dublin City Council receipted €52.7m. €1.4m was received from the Department of Housing, Planning, Community & Local Government, of which €1.3m refers to SICAP Lot 2. Rates received in the 2017 period are €4.6m less (€7.6m against €3m) than the 2016 period as Direct Debits were not processed in the 2017 period. A payment of €1.5m was received from South Dublin County Council in respect of the Fire Services for December 2016. €5.6m was received from Irish Water in respect of payroll and goods and services in November and December 2016. Prior to November 2016, these values were netted off against non-domestic water related receipts.

### Payments

During the period Dublin City Council made payments to the value of €90.9m. €5.1m was paid to the Revenue Commissioners, €4.5m in relation to Value Added Tax. €6.5m was also paid to the Revenue Commissioners in respect of PAYE/PRSI. €1.9m was paid to HFA as Loan Redemptions.

### EU/IMF Reporting

The next report under the EU/IMF reporting framework is for the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2016 (i.e. October – December). The deadline for submission of the EU/IMF reports is 24<sup>th</sup> February 2017. These reports will be included with the Financial Report for the April City Council meeting.
