

RENEWAL OF DUBLIN CITY CENTRE BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT SCHEME

The Local Government (Business Improvement Districts) Act 2006 commencement order was signed by the Minister for Environment, Heritage and Local Government on the 24th April 2007. A BID scheme for Dublin City was subsequently approved in 2007 and expired on December 31st, 2012. A further scheme was approved in 2012 and is due to expire on December 31st, 2017. A proposal to renew the current scheme has been prepared and submitted to the Rates Office of Dublin City Council. This renewal document 'The Strategic Plan for the Renewal of the Dublin City BID' has been prepared by the Dublin City Centre BID Company Ltd.

The BID renewal document will go on public display from 9.00am on Wednesday March 8th, 2017 until 5pm on Friday April 7th, 2017. It will be displayed at the Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8 and also in the Dublin City Council Library in the ILAC Centre, Dublin 1. A public notice will be inserted in a national newspaper to invite submissions from the public on the BID proposal. Submissions will be accepted up to close of business on April 7th, 2017.

Following examination of any submissions and amendments to the proposal, Dublin City Council will hold a plebiscite in accordance with the Local Government (Business Improvement Districts Ratepayer Plebiscite) Regulations 2007.
